<b>Tuesday</b> August 30	In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1
<b>Thursday</b> September 1	For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23
<b>Tuesday</b> September 6	And call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me. Psalm 50:15
<b>Thursday</b> September 8	But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up on wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:31
<b>Tuesday</b> September 13	Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. Colossians 3:20
<b>Thursday</b> September 15	And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28
<b>Tuesday</b> September 20	Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9
<b>Thursday</b> September 22	The First Commandment: You shall have no other gods. <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.
<b>Tuesday</b> September 27	The Second Commandment: You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.
<b>Thursday</b> September 29	<i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.
<b>Tuesday</b> October 4	The Third Commandment: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

<b>Thursday</b> October 6	<i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.
<b>Tuesday</b> October 11	The Fourth Commandment: Honor your father and your mother.
<b>Thursday</b> October 13	<i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.
<b>Tuesday</b> October 18	The Fifth Commandment: You shall not murder.
<b>Thursday</b> October 20	The Sixth Commandment: You shall not commit adultery.
<b>Tuesday</b> October 25	The Seventh Commandment: You shall not steal.
<b>Thursday</b> October 27	The Eighth Commandment: You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
<b>Tuesday</b> November 1	No Memory
<b>Thursday</b> November 3	The Ninth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's house.
<b>Tuesday</b> November 8	The Tenth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.
<b>Thursday</b> November 10	Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6
<b>Tuesday</b> November 15	He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8
<b>Tuesday</b> November 17	Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. Proverbs 3:5

<b>Tuesday</b> January 10	<u>Apostle's Creed—The First Article</u> I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.
<b>Thursday</b> January 12	<b>(The First Article Meaning)</b> <i>What does this mean?</i> I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them.
<b>Tuesday</b> January 17	No Memory
<b>Thursday</b> January 19	<b>(First Article meaning continued)</b> He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life.
<b>Tuesday</b> January 24	<b>(First Article meaning continued)</b> He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me.
<b>Thursday</b> January 26	<b>(First Article meaning continued)</b> For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him. This is most certainly true.
<b>Tuesday</b> January 31	<b><u>The Second Article</u></b> I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried.
<b>Thursday</b> February 2	<b>(The Second Article continued)</b> He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.
<b>Tuesday</b> February 7	<b>(The Second Article Meaning)</b> <i>What does this mean?</i> I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord,
<b>Thursday</b> February 9	<b>(Second Article meaning continued)</b> Who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil;

<b>Tuesday</b> February 14	<b>(Second Article meaning continued)</b> Not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death;
<b>Thursday</b> February 16	<b>(Second Article meaning continued)</b> That I may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.
<b>Tuesday</b> February 21	No Memory
<b>Thursday</b> February 23	<b><u>The Third Article</u></b> I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
<b>Tuesday</b> February 28	<b>(The Third Article Meaning)</b> <i>What does this mean?</i> I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him;
<b>Thursday</b> March 2	<b>(Third Article meaning continued)</b> but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith.
<b>Tuesday</b> March 7	<b>(Third Article meaning continued)</b> In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith.
<b>Thursday</b> March 9	<b>(Third Article meaning continued)</b> In this Christian church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers.
<b>Tuesday</b> March 14	<b>(Third Article meaning continued)</b> On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.
<b>Thursday</b> March 16	I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. John 15:5
<b>Tuesday</b> March 21	Jesus said to him, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6

<b>Thursday</b> March 23	But when Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them, “Let the little children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. Mark 10:14

<b>Thursday</b> April 13	<b>(Hymn—I Know that My Redeemer Lives v. 4)</b> He lives to grant me rich supply; he lives to guide me with His eye; He lives to comfort me when faint. He lives to hear my soul’s complaint.
<b>Tuesday</b> April 18	For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16
<b>Thursday</b> April 20	The Lord’s Prayer: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
<b>Tuesday</b> April 25	<b>(Hymn—Now the Light Has Gone Away L.S.B. 887 v. 1)</b> Now the light has gone away, Father listen while I pray, Asking Thee to watch and keep, and to send me quiet sleep.
<b>Thursday</b> April 27	<b>(Hymn—Now the Light Has Gone Away v. 2)</b> Jesus, Savior wash away, all that has been wrong today; Help me every day to be, good and gentle more like Thee.
<b>Tuesday</b> May 2	<b>(Hymn—A Mighty Fortress is our God L.S.B. 656 v.1 part 1)</b> A mighty fortress is our God, a trusty shield and weapon; He helps us free from every need that hath us now o’er taken.
<b>Thursday</b> May 4	<b>(Hymn—A Mighty Fortress is our God L.S.B. v.1 part 2)</b> The old evil foe, now means deadly woe; Deep guile and great might, are his dread arms in fight; on earth is not his equal.
