- P: Father, as we gather during this Holy Week, we recognize how often we strive for all the wrong things in life. We hold onto shame. We hold on to guilt. We hold on to our own bad behaviors.
- C: **We find it difficult to let go of anger, frustration and all the stuff of life.**
- P: As John the Baptist reminds us... "That joy is mine, and it is now complete. He must become greater; I must become less."
- C: **The One who comes from above is above all; the One who is from the earth belongs to the earth, and speaks as one from the earth. The One who comes from heaven is above all.**
- P: As we seek to become less, we confess our sins to You this Holy Week. Help us to join with those who shouted Your praises on Palm Sunday -- their cry of "Hosanna to the Son of David" becomes our prayer.
- C: **Hosanna! Lord save us! Lord give us life! Lord fill us with more of You!**
- P: We have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.
- C: **He was delivered up to death; He was delivered for the sins of the people.**
- P: He must become greater,
- C: **We must become less.**
- P: Trusting this as your confession...
- C: **Amen.**
- P: Christ has died; Christ has risen; Christ will come again!
- C: **Amen. Come Lord Jesus. Come.**

Reading - Philippians 2:5-11

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though He was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

P: This is the Word of the Lord...

C: Thanks be to God.

Gospel

- John 12:12–19

P: The Holy Gospel according to...

C: **Glory to You, O Lord.**

... The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, crying out, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!" And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written,

*"Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming,
sitting on a donkey's colt!"*

His disciples did not understand these things at first, but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written about Him and had been done to Him. The crowd that had been with Him when He called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to bear witness. The reason why the crowd went to meet Him was that they heard He had done this sign. So the Pharisees said to one another, "You see that you are gaining nothing. Look, the world has gone after him."

P: This the Gospel of our Lord...

C: **Praise to You, O Christ.**

And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets. And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church, I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
