January 22-26, 2024

This week we will learn all about the Letter S and the number 14. We will continue working with our colors gray and white, our ABCD pattern, and our shape the star. Please keep working on recognizing and writing our letters (capital & lowercase) as well as our numbers. When writing letters, help your child connect the sounds with letters. We will also have some fun crafts and books this week relating to Groundhog Day!

& MORE...During our workshop time this week, we will work with our positional words and create a Skittles rainbow. At our centers, we will work with our #14 play-doh writing mats, play in kinetic sand, create our letter S alphabet book page with stamps, and work with shadows. For art, we will turn the letter S into a spider and make a groundhog puppet. We will read The Very Busy Spider and Groundhog Gets a Say.

IN THE AFTERNOON this week, we will work with the book Even Superheroes Have Bad Days. We will discuss emotions and our very own 'bad days.' We will work with the beginning S sound and illustrate Superhero related prompts. Our STEM activity this week will be building a tower with index cards and dixie cups. We will also create our very own Superhero masks and an actual Superhero.

In Jesus Time we will hear the story of Jesus choosing the 12 disciples. The disciples worked in many different jobs, but they were special to Jesus. These men were to be Jesus' helpers here on earth. We have also been called to be Jesus' helpers and like the disciples, He too helps us to show love to one another. We will also have chapel this week with Mrs. G. We can't wait to hear her message of Jesus' love!
