

## Math, Music, & Science News



Today in math, students met a new friend, Anita the Adding Alligator. We read Anita's book, Combining Sets and heard a new song, Here is the Beehive. We learned how to combine or add sets up to 5 with objects and our fingers. Check out our beehive mat and bees and watch us add! Anita will be with us for a few weeks, teaching us multiple strategies for adding.

Today in science, students were challenged to work as engineers to design and build a straw tower that can stand on its own. After learning to build simple shapes (square, triangle, pyramid, cube) with straws and connectors, and discussing stability and balance, students worked to build the tallest tower.

This week in music, we learned about a new instrument, the triangle! We can strike different sides of the triangle and hold it tighter or loser for a different sound. We each got a turn making music with the triangle. Next up, will learn all about the handbells. We are also continuing to work very hard on our songs for our spring program!
