March 18-22, 2024

This week will be a review week. We will work with our letters R, U, X and our numbers 18-20. We will work with our numbers and the quantities they represent. We will continue practice writing our names and work with the colors of the rainbow, our AABB pattern, and our shape, the diamond. We will also continue working on our sight words. We are beginning week 25 of our Heggerty program. We are working with rhyming words, beginning and ending sounds, blending and segmenting words, changing and taking away initial sounds, and letter sounds.

& MORE...This week, we will continue with our review theme. We will continue with our Read & Draw activities. At center time, we will write our name some fun ways, trace and write our numbers 1-10, play in our gel balls, and build on the light table. For our group art this week, we will make an Easter basket. We will also read *This Plus That* and *Elemenopee*.

IN THE AFTERNOON this week, we will work with the book, There Was an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Chick. We will work with vocabulary words, story sequences, and the life cycle of a chick. We will complete some Easter crafts and learn all about chicks.

In Jesus Time we will be discussing Holy Week, which begins on Palm Sunday. Jesus was welcomed with palm branches and Hosannas, and then spent time with His disciples, washing their feet and enjoying the last supper before He was to be punished. We will also discuss the story of Jesus' death and resurrection. Jesus was God's greatest gift to us and because He lived, died, and rose, we will one day enjoy eternal life in Heaven!

Easter Party is this week, Thursday, 3/21. We will have regular class from 8:30-10 and then our party will be from 10-11. Full day students will still attend all day.
