During center time, we will make flower pots, find, color, and count shapes, play a baseball do a dot letter game, and create pool noodle boats. We will make a handprint crab beach scene and read a book called *Planet Kindergarten*.

IN THE AFTERNOON this week, we will work with the book *Giraffes Can't Dance*. We will work with vocabulary, character, setting, problem, and solution, and story sequence. We will create a cute giraffe handprint craft. Because it is our last week, we will spend lots of time outside, enjoying the playground as well.

We've learned all about the Bible this year in preschool. What an important culminating message to know that Jesus is our best friend.
