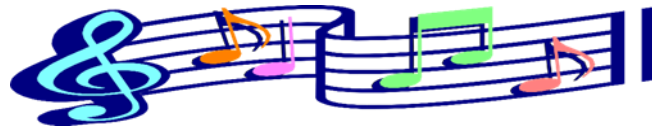


Vine Connection Time this Wednesday (3/12)

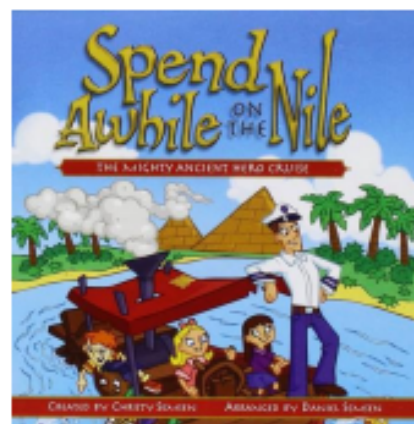


ANNOUNCING this Spring's Grades 1-4 Operetta...
