



## Math, Music, & Science News

Today in math we met a new friend, Scooter the Subtracting Sea Turtle, and worked with early subtraction skills. We learned how to subtract sets within 5. Preschoolers learned a new song, "Five Little Bunnies" and a new vocabulary word, *Take Away*. Students used a subtracting sets mat and bunnies to 'take away' from a larger group. Ask your child to show you how they can subtract with their mats and bunnies!

In science today, students headed outdoors to create Easter egg rockets and exploding baggies! They made two different chemical reactions releasing carbon dioxide gas. The first, using citric acid and sodium bicarbonate (Alka-Seltzer) and the second, with vinegar and baking soda. Students learned that the trapped gas creates 'pressure' inside the egg and baggie. The force became so great it had to escape, creating a small explosion in our case.

We haven't played a singing circle game in a while, so this week, we will certainly make time for "Apple Tree" and our new favorite, "Bow-Wow-Wow". But first, we must revisit some music theory concepts we have learned - like counting, ear training, the musical staff, and note values. After that, we'll sing and dance to some fun songs, old and new, and THEN we'll play!



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
