This week we will learn all about the Letter D and the Number 5. We will continue working with our colors black and orange, our shape the triangle, and our AAB pattern. Have you seen your child's letter recognition books? Have your child read to you all about our letter of the week!

& More... This week during science workshop we will create our own dinosaur fossils and during literacy workshop we will create, draw, and name our very own dinosaur. During center time we will create shape dinosaurs, make our letter D alphabet book page with diamond stickers, play with dinosaurs in kinetic sand, and melt frozen dinosaur eggs. We will be making a pumpkin craft and a duck craft. We will continue with our Round 1 of Happy Talk.

IN THE AFTERNOON this week...During fine motor time, we will play a roll and trace letter game, play in kinetic sand, and create play-doh tacos and donuts. We will complete literacy units on *Dragons Love Tacos* (1 & 2) and *If You Give a Dog a Donut*. For dragons, we will map out the story, complete a comprehension, act out parts of the story, draw and tell about our favorite parts of the story, and create a taco and a fire breathing dragon (2-day project). For donuts, we will retell the story using pictures, draw and tell items the dog wanted, and create a puffy paint donut (2-day project).

In Jesus time, we will be learning about Samuel. God chose Samuel to speak His word to the people of Israel. Samuel helped the people remember to listen to God. God had a special plan for Samuel, just like He has a special plan for all of us. We should always spread the good news of God, making sure all those around us know of His love.

Fine Motor Skills are an essential part of preschool learning! At home, let your child explore and grow independently. Opening doors, putting on clothes and shoes, using utensils at meal times, cutting and gluing, playing with play-doh, pinch gripping pencils and crayons...these are all ways to help your child strengthen their fine motor skills, which will aid in their classroom success. In preschool, we are working on our writing grip and scissor skills. When we write we use the tripod or pinch grip. With this grip, we are able to control our coloring and writing movements. We also carefully color, filling in and staying in the lines. When we cut, we are always safe because scissors are sharp. We move the paper with one hand and cut with the other, using an 'open/shut' movement. These are some very important skills in preschool. The more we practice, the stronger these skills become!

Fall progress reports will go home near the end of October. In regards to these early evaluations, <u>please</u> remember that the spectrum of preschool performance is huge and progress is not always made at a steady rate. Do not be too concerned if your child has areas that need improvement. However, practice in any skill is encouraged.
