

What's in Store for PK4 & More Mrs. DeMarsh

November 3-7, 2025

This week we will learn all about the Letter H and the Number 8. We will review our ABB pattern, the square, and our blue and brown colors. Have you seen your child's letter recognition books? Have your child read to you all about our letter of the week! We are also continuing work with our Heggerty program. Students are doing well recognizing beginning and ending sounds, insolating syllables, and even working with nursery rhymes and rhyming.

& More...This week during workshop, we will create a handprint turkey. During center time we will play a Thanksgiving themed math roll and cover game, create our letter H alphabet book page, play with farm animals in corn, and create with legos on the light table. We will be making an H is for horse craft. We will read Hullabaloo at the Zoo.

IN THE AFTERNOON this week...During fine motor time, we will play with play-doh, giant water beads, and play with fall themed fine motor pieces. We will complete literacy units on Harry the Dirty Dog and We're Going on a Leaf Hunt. For Harry, we will read an easy reader book, create a thaumatrope, make a dog headband, work with character, problem, and solution, and make a clean and dirty Harry. For leaf hunt, we will do a number and letter leaf sort, create marbled leaves, and make an edible tree with pretzels, frosting, and fruit snacks.

In Jesus Time we will be talking about the story of Daniel and the lions' den. Daniel worked for the king in Israel. He also loved the Lord, praying and praising Him often. A law was then passed that no one should worship anyone but the king, but Daniel continued to pray to the Lord. He was punished and sent to the lions' den. Because of his love for the Lord, God sent an angel and closed the lions' mouths to save Daniel. Our God is so mighty!!
